Ordinance Office to lay before them an Account of what Stores had  
formerly been sent to Barbados and at what times -
- 2<sup>d</sup> April 1734 Return made by the Office of Ordnance to the above Order -
- 11<sup>d</sup> D<sup>o</sup> - Representation made by the Board of Trade for sending a Supply  
of Stores to the Leeward Islands and also some Recruits for the  
Regiment quartered there -
- 17<sup>d</sup> D<sup>o</sup> - His Majesty referred this Representation to a Committee -
- 18<sup>d</sup> D<sup>o</sup> - The Committee considered thereof together with the above Papers  
relating to Barbados and Ordered the Board of Trade to get  
the best information they could of what Stores were necessary  
for the Defence of Barbados and all the Leeward Islands and to  
inspect the Laws for raising Money for repair of the  
Fortifications for establishing a Militia or other Defence of the  
Islands, and to enquire what Money had been charged and  
raised on the Inhabitants of each of the Islands for the said  
purposes and to what uses such Money had been applied  
and likewise to enquire into the reason of the Decrease of White  
Men in the said Islands -

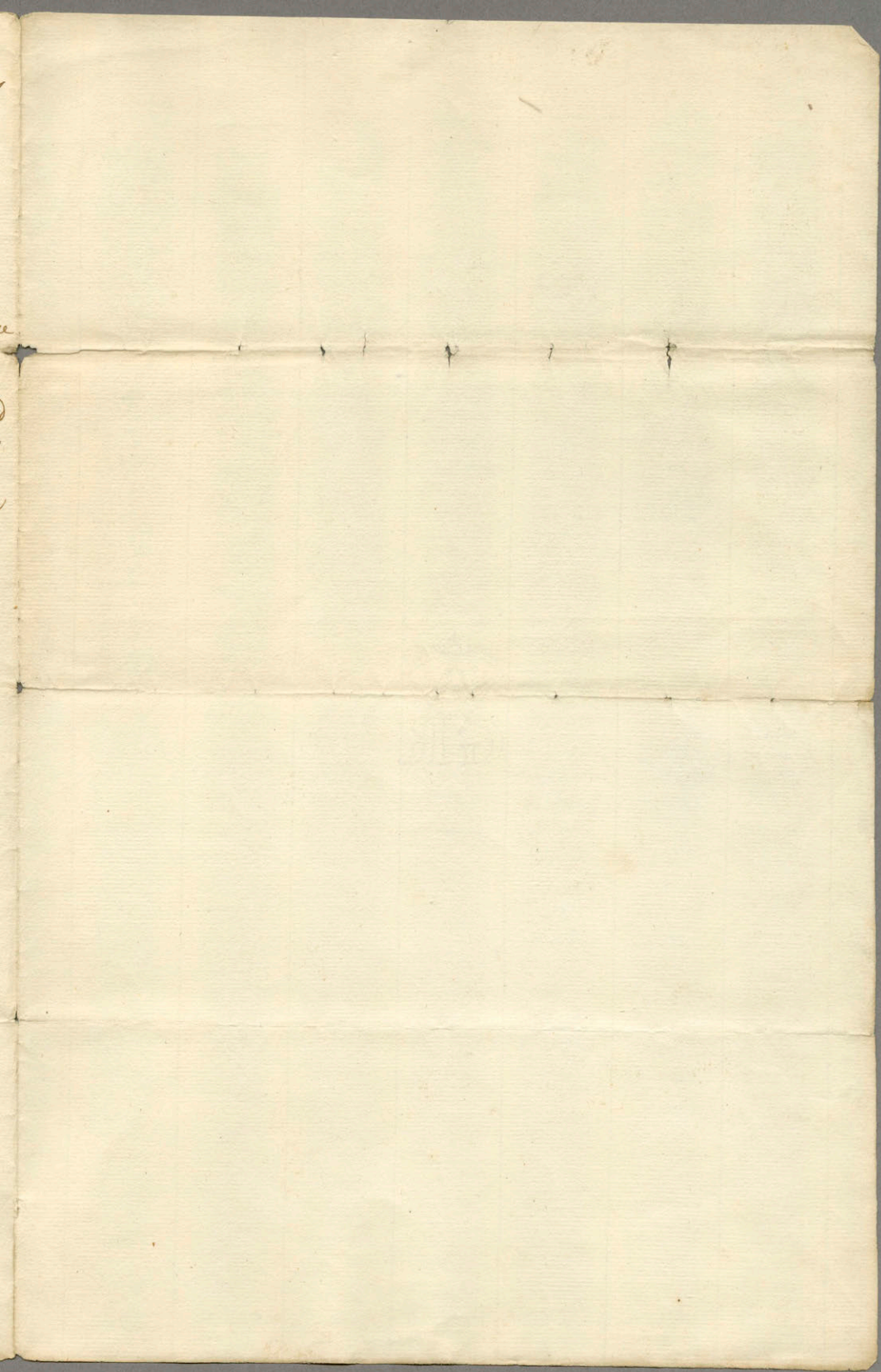
Office should send an Account of what Ordnance and Small Arms

of Ordnance should prepare Estimates of the Charge of Arms  
Reported by the Board of Trade to be necessary for Barbados and  
the Leeward Islands distinguishing the Value of those which  
were proposed to be paid for by the Crown from those to be paid for  
by the respective Islands. —
