

Abstract of a Letter from Mr. Grey Goo^r
of Barbados. Post. the 17th June 99.

His Maj^{ty}'s Service will suffer very much in all probability —
without having 2 or 3 men of Warr continually here; yesterday
Capt. Parker Commander of His Maj^{ty}'s Ship Speedwell returned
from cruizing, who informs me that Captⁿ Billingsley Commander
of the Queenborough was in Chase of Kidd the Pirate, who had on
board to the Value of 400000^l, but about ten white men and the
rest all Negroes, and that he mist of her but about six hours, that
he is given to understand this Pirate is gone to joine the Patch
at their Settlement.
